Binoculars

## What you need to make binoculars:

- 2 toilet paper tubes
- Black electrical tape
- Foam sheets or construction paper
- Scissors
- Tacky glue
- Ruler
- Single hole punch
- Yarn or string

## Instructions:

1. Measure your toilet paper roll tube and cut a strip of construction paper the length of your tube and long enough to go around the entire tube. Then glue the paper to the tube. Remember you can use any color you want to use.





2. Now cut a strip of electrical tape and add it to the end of each tube (if you don't have tape you can use another piece of construction paper), then cut a strip of construction paper and glue it in the center of the tape.






3. Now glue your tubes together.



4. Print the "wings" template" and cut them out. Trace them onto pieces of foam or you can use construction paper if you don't have foam or you can color the template feathers and use those. After you cut them out make small cuts along each wings edges to create feathers.



5. Next, glue the feathers together like this. Let those dry for a while.



6. Use a single hole punch and punch a hole at the top of the binoculars on each side, like the picture below. Then, cut a piece of yarn and tie it to both sides using the punched holes.





7. Glue a set of wings on each side of your binoculars.
