## Elephants

## "Remember to Love like God Loves"



What you need to make your elephant:

- 4 sheets of construction paper $9 \times 12$
- 2 google eyes
- Scissors
- Tacky glue
- Stapler
- Tape

How to make an elephant:

1. Pick out 4 sheets of construction paper and fold 3 of them in half.

2. Unfold the 3 papers and cut on the fold line in half.

3. Take a half sheet and roll it up for a leg. I over lapped the paper a little over an inch. Use glue to secure, you can also add a piece of tape to hold it if needed.

4. Do the same for the next 3 legs.

5. While the legs dry make the head doing the same thing, roll the paper but make this one bigger than the legs.

6. While your pieces are drying, take the last full sheet of paper and trace two circles for the ears. I used a glass to make the circles, it was about 4" across. Then cut out the circles.

7. Now cut a trunk and a tail, then bend the end for gluing later.

8. Now that all the pieces are glued together, get a stapler and staple the legs together like this. All 4 legs are stapled together.

9. Take your last half sheet and lay it next to the legs, cut the half sheet to the width of the legs

10. Let's attach the body. Put a couple dots of glue on the body and place it over two of the legs. You have to let this dry completely before you attach the other side.

11. Now that the first side is dry, flip the elephant over and attach the other side the same way. You can hold this until it is dry or turn it over again and place the side you just glued down, it should hold. Don't push too hard, you don't want to squish your elephant! Let it dry all the way before you pick it up.

12. While you are waiting for the body to dry you can work on the head. Place some glue on each of the ears and insert them into the head like this.

13. Let's add the eyes and a trunk to the head.

14. After the glue on the body and the head are dry. Attach the head to the body. Add some glue to the body and place on the elephants head.

15. All that is left is to add the elephants tail

16. Your elephant is ready for an adventure -$)$
