

Hakuna Matata Sign

“No Worries”



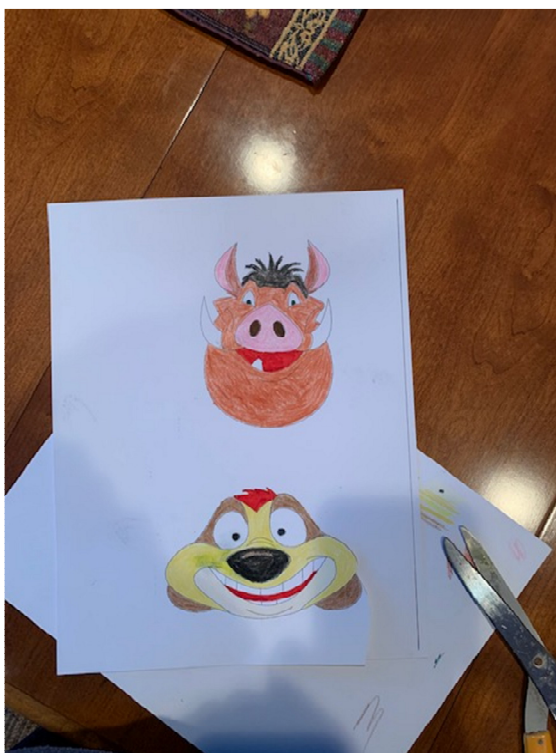
Materials for your sign:

- Print the templates on card stock paper
- Scissors
- Ribbon
- Tape
- Crayons or markers (optional)
- Single hole punch
- A bunch of flowers or feathers or beads or anything you like to decorate with

1. Print the sign template and the Timon and Pumba template. You can print the already colored Timon and Pumba or you can print the template to color yourself.



2. If you choose the pictures to color, color those now.



3. Now cut out your Pumba and Timon and your sign



4. Using your hole punch, punch two holes in the top of the sign and two holes in the bottom of the sign.



5. Cut some yarn and tie it to the two holes on the top of the sign to hang your sign when you are through. Then cut two pieces of yarn and attach Timon and Pumba to your sign.



6. Cut some ribbons, make them different lengths and tape them to the back of the sign



7. Now for the fun part. Add decorations to your ribbons. First, I cut off the flowers from the bunch, then I tied each flower to the yellow ribbons, then I cut off the green leaves and attached them to the green ribbons.



If you don't have flowers **"HAKUNA MATATA-NO WORRIES"** you can add things like beads or feathers to the ribbons. I taped the ribbons to the table then tied feather on the green ribbons and added beads to the yellow ribbon, then attached them to the back of my sign.
