*"Hear me roar"*

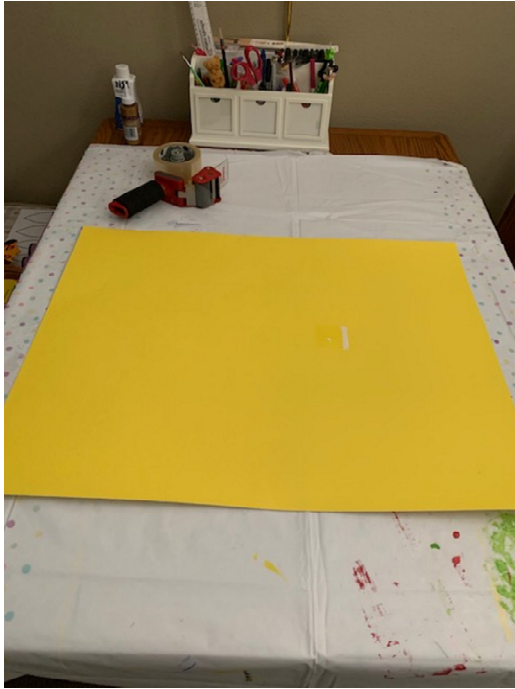


## Materials for Megaphone Craft

- Large sheet of paper or poster board
- Tape
- Scissors
- Small, red boa or fluffy, red yarn
- Glue
- Construction paper

# How to make a Megaphone

1. Roll a large piece of paper or poster board into a cone shape. Tape into place.



2. Cut off the bottom of your cone to level both sides and create your megaphone shape.



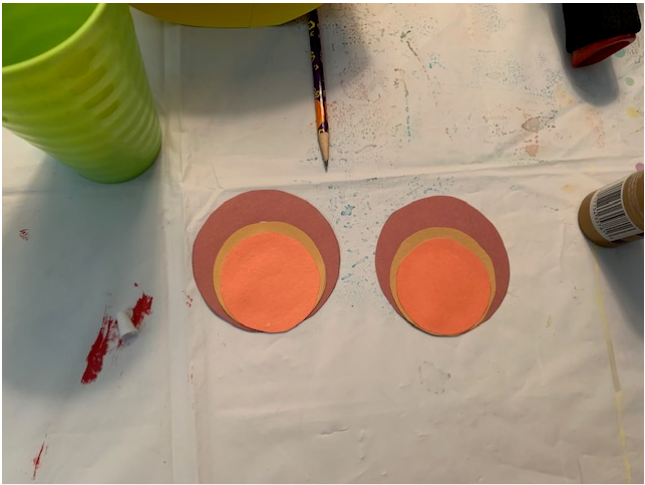
- Put a bunch on glue at the top of the megaphone and curl up the boa to make a circle then run a strip of glue down the megaphone and create a "Mohawk" with the boa.



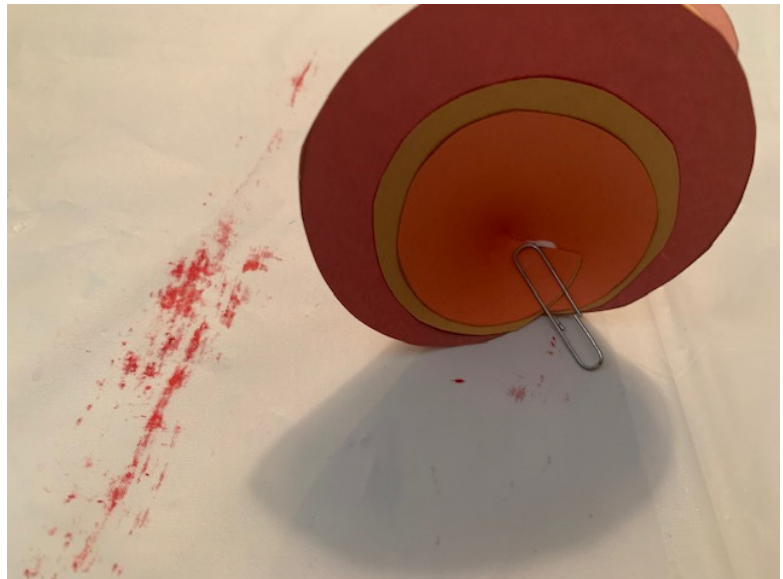
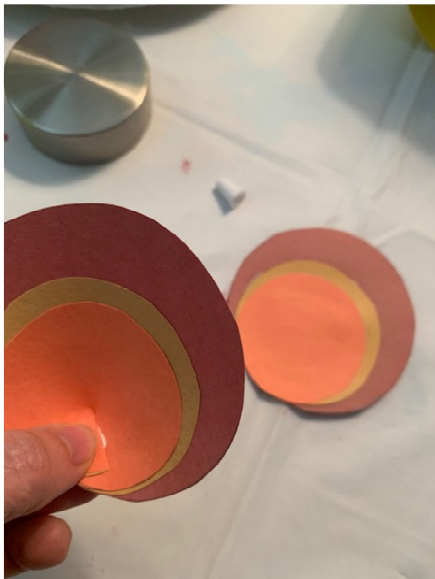
- Trace some paper ears from construction paper. Use something to make 3 different size circles. I used both sides of a glass and a top from a water bottle.



5. Cut out your circles and glue them together like this.



6. Make a snip in the bottom of the ears. Fold the two resulting tabs together creating a 3-d effect. Add some glue and use a paper clip to hold them together until they are dry.



7. Glue the ears onto your megaphone on each side of the boa. Use paper clips to hold them on until they are dry



Use your megaphone to roar along with Simba!
