

Rafiki Mask – Construction Paper

“Marked”



What you'll need to make a Rafiki mask:

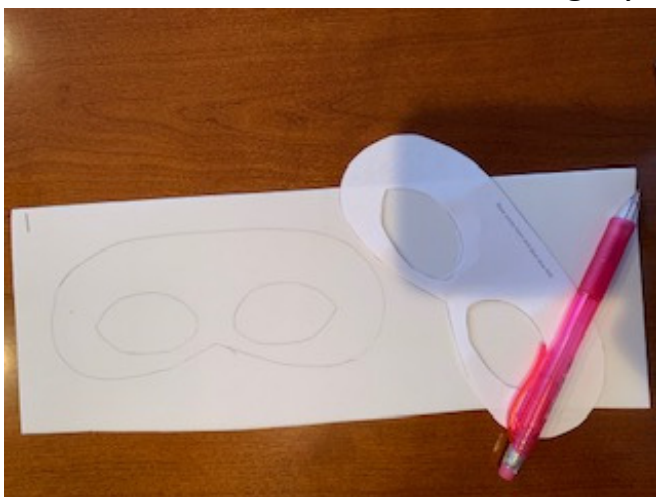
- Gray and white craft foam
- Yellow, white, dark blue, light blue, and red construction paper
- Black marker
- Tacky glue
- Scissors
- Yarn

Instructions to make a Rafiki mask with paper:

1. Download and print the Rafiki mask template. Cut out template pieces



2. Trace the mask body onto white foam, then do the same for the eyebrows. Next, trace the hair tuft onto the gray foam



3. Cut out all of the foam pieces



4. Trace the rest of the pieces onto the corresponding colored construction paper and cut them out.

5. Glue the dark blue mask piece over the white foam mask piece



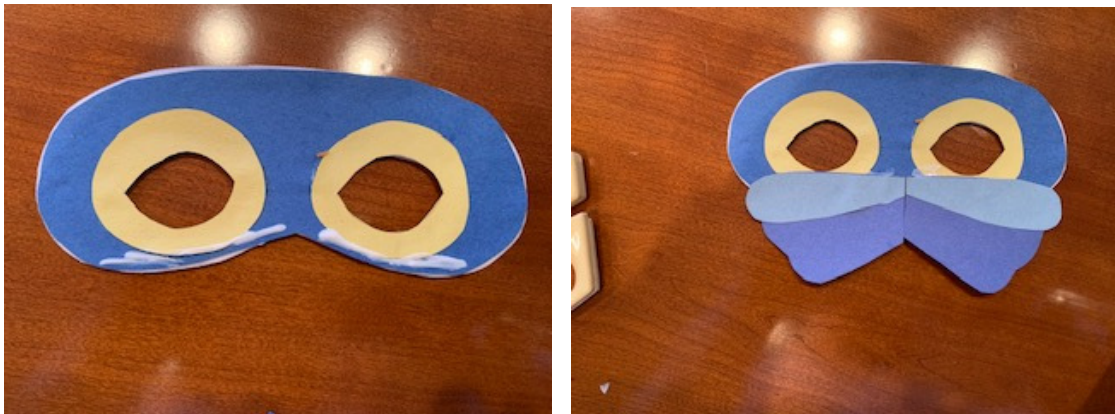
6. Glue the yellow eyes on the mask



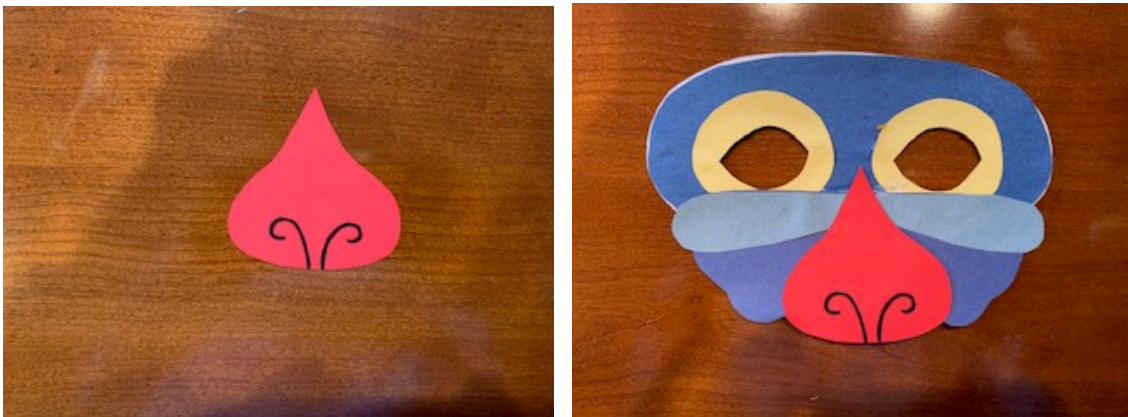
7. Next, glue the light blue pieces onto the dark blue pieces.



8. Glue on the face pieces by putting a little glue on the edge of the mask then place the face pieces on. Cover the eyes slightly.



9. Next draw lines on the red nose then glue the nose on but do not put glue on the upper part, leave the pointy part free from glue for now. We will glue it down later.



10. Glue the white side fur to each side of the mask



11. Glue the top white fur pieces to the mask. Put glue on the top of the mask and then add the white fur pieces.



12. Glue on the gray foam hair tuff to the top of the mask.



13. Glue the eyebrows on, lift the tip of the nose to put the eyebrow underneath. Then glue the top of the nose in place.



14. Now use your holes punch and punch two holes for the ties. One on each side of the mask.



15. Cut two pieces of yarn and tie one to each side of the mask.



Your mask is ready to wear 😊
