Simba "Marked from the beginning"




Materials need to make your Simba:

- Printed templates, two pages
- Toilet paper tube
- White cardstock paper
- Scissors
- Glue

How to make Simba:

1. Print out the two templates on white cardstock paper, it is stronger and durable.



2. Then cut out all of the shapes with scissors. You can simply cut out the shapes very loosely, it doesn't have to be perfect.



3. Wrap the large rectangular piece around a toilet paper tube and secure with glue. Line it up with the bottom of the roll.




4. Glue on Simba's head. It will cover the top of the roll.



5. Glue on the front feet. They should stick out a little on the sides.



6. Glue on the back feet so that you can see it from the front. Put the glue on the edge of the foot. Then do the opposite on the other side.





7. Now bend the tail on the white edge like this.



8. Glue on Simba's tail, here is a picture from the back of Simba so you can see where to put the tail.
